■ Eligibility





Requirements (All of the following requirements must be met)

- The applicants are a married couple whose marriage registration was submitted and accepted **between March 1, 2023 and March 31, 2024**.
- The couple's total income from January 1 to December 31, 2022 was **less than 4 million yen**.
* If the applicant is currently repaying scholarship loans, the amount of annual repayment will be deducted from the couple's household income during calculations.
- Both spouses are **42 years old or below** as of the date of their marriage.
- The address of the newlyweds at the time of their application is the residence considered in the application.
- The applicants have not received a similar type of subsidy from the national or local government under other laws or regulations.
- The applicants must be willing to live in Matsudo City for at least two years from the date the subsidy is provided.
- None of the applicants are a member of organized crime groups, as defined in Article 2, Item 6 of the "Act on Prevention of Unjust Acts by Organized Crime Group Members".
