# Housing Support Subsidy for Newly Weds

For households where both husband wife are...

- 29 years old or younger: Up to 600,000 yen
- 39 years old or younger: Up to 300,000 yen

Matsudo City subsidizes, within budgetary limits, the actual cost incurred by newly-married households

# Eligibility for the 2026 Fiscal Year

## Requirements (All of the following requirements must be met)

- Both spouses take one of the lectures** designated by the city within the approved fiscal year.
- The applicants are a married couple whose marriage registration was submitted and accepted **between January 1, 2026 and March 31, 2027**.
- The couple's total income from **January 1 to December 31, 2025** was **less than 5 million yen**. \* If the applicant is currently repaying scholarship loans, the amount of annual repayment will be deducted from the couple's household income during calculations.
- Both spouses are **39 years old or below** as of the date of their marriage.
- The address of the newlyweds at the time of their application is the residence considered in the application.
- The applicants have not received a similar type of subsidy from the national or local government under other laws or regulations.
- The applicants must be willing to live in Matsudo City for at least two years from the date the subsidy is provided.
- None of the applicants are a member of organized crime groups, as defined in Article 2, Item 3 of the "Act on Prevention of Unjust Acts by Organized Crime Group Members".

## Subsidized Expenses

※ All of the following payments must be made **between April 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025**

● <b>Housing Acquisition Expenses</b>	The <b>cost of purchasing a building</b> for a house upon marriage (Construction and/or purchase of a new house, purchase of a used house)
● <b>Housing Rental Expenses</b>	Expenses for housing rented upon marriage Deposit, Key money, Agency fee, Rent & Common service fee (up to two months)
● <b>Moving Expenses</b>	<b>Expenses paid to a moving company</b> for moving upon marriage (This does not apply if you moved yourselves, or asked friends to help you)
● <b>Renovation Costs</b>	<b>Expenses</b> for repairs, expansion, reconstruction, and renewal of facilities in order to maintain or improve the function of the house out of the renovation upon marriage

## Subsidy Amount

**[NOTE]** The maximum subsidy amount varies depending on the new couple's age

As of their date of marriage;

- Both spouses are **29 years old or younger** : Subsidized up to **600,000 yen**
- Excluding the above,  
both spouses are **39 years old or younger** : Subsidized up to **300,000 yen**
