Dispose of Electronic Devices Whose Lithium Batteries Cannot Be Removed on Recyclable Items Collection Days!

Many rechargeable electronic devices—such as electronic cigarettes and portable batteries—have lithium-ion batteries built into them. These batteries cannot be removed, and using excessive force to try to do so raises the risk of the device overheating and even igniting. Please dispose of these items on the collection day for recyclable items.



Check the Garbage Collection Schedule of Your Community

Household garbage collection schedules vary depending on the community you live in. The collection day for recyclable items and hazardous and other garbage is the standard date. Please check the chart below for the standard date examples and write your area's collection days in the circle on the chart to the left. If you do not know the standard date for your community, please ask the Environmental Management Section.

How to Dispose of Bulk Garbage

1 Make a reservation by telephone

Bulk Garbage Reception Center, Tel: 047-391-0007

Reception Hours: 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Closed: Sundays, national holidays, substitute holidays, and from December 29 to January 3

Notes: Because many people call the wrong number, please be sure to dial the correct one. The center is also extremely crowded at the end of the year and during moving season, so please call for a reservation as early as possible.

2 Purchase a handling coupon

Please purchase one "bulk garbage coupon" per bulk garbage (¥1,000 per coupon) at a coupon-handling outlet.

Note: For information on the coupon-handling outlet nearest you, please either check the Matsudo City website or ask the Environmental Management Section.

3 Attach the handling coupon

Please write your name and the date of collection on the "bulk garbage coupon" and attach it to your bulk garbage.

Tear off the receipt (right-side portion), and keep it for your records until your item has been collected.

4 Dispose of the bulk garbage

Location: Detached house: In front of the gate, by the garage facing the street, etc. Apartment/condominium: Near the entrance on the ground floor, or near the garbage collection site

Note: Collection staff cannot go inside your home to pick up items.

Hours: Please place items at the designated location by 8:30 a.m. of the collection day.

Note: Depending on the item, it may be reused or recycled to overall reduce garbage levels.

Bulk Garbage Samples

Items measuring 50 cm or more in length are considered as bulk garbage. Note: Please be aware that even some items measuring less than 50 cm will be considered bulk garbage.

Announcement

Subsidies for Kitchen Scrap Disposals

Matsudo City offers subsidies for the purchase of kitchen scrap disposals (compost boxes and effective-microorganism sealed containers) and electric kitchen scrap disposals.

It is illegal to burn garbage yourself.

Business-related waste from shops and offices cannot be disposed of with household garbage!

Collection Box for Shoes, Bags, and Belts

- Items that can be collected: Leather shoes, sneakers, handbags, belts, etc.
- Items that cannot be collected: Rubber boots, boots, spikes, randoseru, suitcases, golf bags, etc.; also, items that are soiled, damaged, or smell bad.
- Place shoes in pairs in a transparent plastic bag so that the contents can be seen.
- Please confirm the business hours for each facility where collection boxes are located.

Small Appliances Collection Box

Small appliances that fit into the opening of the collection box (30 cm wide x 15 cm long) are collected.

- Notebook computers
- Tablets
- Mobile phones
- Cameras
- Portable game devices
- Electronic dictionaries
- Portable music players

Notes: 1. Items other than those above can be placed in the collection box so long as they fit into the opening of the collection box.

2. Personal information is your own liability; please be sure to delete all data before disposal.

3. Please remove batteries. Please do not put batteries into the collection box.

4. Please confirm the business hours for each facility where collection boxes are located.

How to Dispose of Home Medical Waste

Waste generated during home medical care includes sharp objects such as injection needles, so these items cannot be disposed of at the collection site. To protect city residents and the collection staff from accidents, please consult your family doctor or your local pharmacy about the disposal of these items.

- Items that can be collected at shops, etc.
- Medical items purchased at a pharmacy or drugstore that have expired and are no longer needed
- Prescription medicine you received at a pharmacy after being examined at a medical institution that you no longer need. (This includes medicine that is taken internally or applied externally.)
- Used hypodermic needles and containers
- Items that cannot be collected at shops, etc.
- Industrial items and agricultural chemicals

Taking Items to the Garbage Processing Facility Yourself

You can bring a one-time large amounts of garbage or garbage from moving (excluding paper and cloth items) directly to the following garbage processing facilities yourself (fee charged)

Notes:

- Bringing in your garbage yourself is restricted to one facility and once per day. The maximum amount you can bring varies by type of items. Please call the facility for details.
- The location you should take your garbage to depends on the type of item.
- The facilities are extremely busy on Saturdays, immediately after Golden Week, the year-end/New Year period and national holidays.

● Handling Fee ¥16 per kg, plus consumption tax

- Note: Garbage weighing less than 20 kg will still be calculated as 20 kg, and charged for accordingly (¥320 plus consumption tax).
- For garbage over 20 kg, additional fees will be charged in 10-kg units.

Please be sure to call the facility to receive approval before bringing your garbage.
