

## Use of “My Number” will start from January

From January 2016, you will be required to report your “My Number” when you go through legally stipulated administrative procedures that are related to social security, taxation, and disaster response, for which you need to present your “Notification Card” or “Individual Number Card”. The said procedures are only examples among many. Business owners need to get presentation of “My Number” from their employees as they need it when they proceed with the procedures for taxation and social insurance. Also there may be the case where you will be required to present your “My Number” by financial institutions like a securities company, an insurance company and others.

### Precautions when you use “My Number”

- You need some proof for your “My Number”

You need to present “Notification Card” or “Individual Number Card” to verify your “My Number” which you filled in an application form or other paper.

- Identity verification is compulsory

In order to prevent impersonation fraud, you are required to prove yourself by an identification when you use your “My Number” for some procedures.

- You will never be asked to tell “My Number” by phone

The law stipulates the scope where “My Number” can be used. And identity verification is strictly carried out when you use your “My Number” for the procedures, so you will never be asked to tell your “My Number” by phone. If you got any suspicious call, cut the phone right away, and if you feel uneasy with that call, you can contact the consumer hotline No. 188 (IYAYA) or police station for consultation.
